**Rules and Regulations**

1. All breed animals for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 1:00 to 4:00 pm on Thursday, July 10, 2008.
2. 4-H and Vocational Sheep Breed Show will be held on Thursday, July 10, 2008 at 6:00 pm.
3. Breed sheep will be released on Saturday, July 12, 2008 at 3:00 pm.
4. No more than eight sheep per exhibitor, four per breed, will be accepted. Two entries per exhibitor per individual class; one per group class. Two breeds allowed per exhibitor.
5. Lambs – born after August 31, 2007.
6. Yearlings – born after August 31, 2006.
7. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days prior to the opening date of the fair is required. No brucellosis test is required if the animal originates from a brucellosis free state. No tuberculosis test is required if the animal is coming from an Accredited Tuberculosis-free herd. Herd test dates and certified free herd number must appear on the health certificate.
8. All sheep to be exhibited must be identified with official USDA scrapie identification. Sheep from flocks on the Scrapie Flock Certification Program must bear an official ear+age, tattoo, electronic eartag or electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader).
9. Vaccination against rabies is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition.

All exhibitors are:

- subject to the General Rules and Regulations,
- expected to adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics and Guidelines for the Care of Animals,
- and required to comply with the Livestock Health Requirements.
