**Rules and Regulations**

1. Entries open to amateurs only.
2. All exhibits must be entered Sunday, July 6, 2008 from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Exhibits will be released on Sunday, July 13, 2008 from 12:00 to 3:00 pm
3. Arrangement container must be labeled on the bottom with name and address of exhibitor.
4. All cut flower specimens must have been grown by the exhibitor, flowers in arrangements must be homegrown.
5. Cut flower specimens should be in a clear jar or bottle; arrangements can be in any type of container and suitable size for flowers.
6. All potted plants must have been grown by the exhibitor or in his/her possession for at least three months. Any size pot may be exhibited, except where specified.
7. Ribbons and premiums will be awarded in each class. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected.

Any exhibits removed PRIOR to the release time will forfeit premiums.

**NOTE: To make sure that flower exhibits are presentable by the end of the week, all exhibitors are requested to refresh their flower exhibits midweek.**
