**Rules and Regulations**

1. All animals for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm Tuesday, July 8, 2008.
2. Open Market Lamb show will be Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at 6:00 pm.
3. Market sheep will be released Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at 11:00 pm.
4. No more than four lambs per exhibitor will be accepted.
5. All market lambs will be weighed on the same set of scales on Tuesday, July 8, 2008 upon arrival. Exhibitor must be present at weigh-in.
6. All lambs for the Pair of Lambs class must be in the same weight class.
7. All Market Lambs must be slick shorn from the knee and hock up at the time of weighing. Lambs with excessive wool will not be weighed until shorn to meet the satisfaction of the superintendent.
8. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days prior to the opening date of the fair is required. No brucellosis test is required if the animal originates from a brucellosis free state. No tuberculosis test is required if the animal is coming from an Accredited Tuberculosis-free herd. Herd test dates and certified free herd number must appear on the health certificate.
9. All sheep to be exhibited must be identified with official USDA scrapie identification. Sheep from flocks on the Scrapie Flock Certification Program must bear an official ear+age, tattoo, electronic eartag or electronic implant device (the exhibitor must supply a reader).
10. Vaccination against rabies is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition.
