Rules and Regulations

1. All market goats for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds prior to 3:00 pm on Monday, July 7, 2008.
2. Open Market Goat Show (combined with Junior Show) will be held Tuesday, July 8, 2008 at 6:00 pm. Open breeding goat show (combined with Junior Show) will be held Monday, July 7, 2008 at 6:00 pm.
3. Market Goats will be released on Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at 11:00 pm.
4. No more than three market goats per exhibitor will be accepted.
5. All market goats must weigh a minimum of 40 lbs. and over and not be over one year of age.
6. All market goats will be weighed on the same set of scales on Monday evening, when announced by superintendent. Exhibitor must be present at weigh-in. All goats will be mouthed at scale. Animals with yearling teeth will be disqualified.
7. All breeding goats will be shown as crossbred, limited to two (2) per class.
8. All castration wounds must be healed.
9. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days prior to the opening date of the fair is required. No brucellosis test is required if the animal originates from a brucellosis free state. No tuberculosis test is required if the animal is coming from an Accredited Tuberculosis-free herd. Herd test dates and certified free herd number must appear on the health certificate.
10. Vaccination against rabies is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition.

- and required to comply with the Livestock Health Requirements.

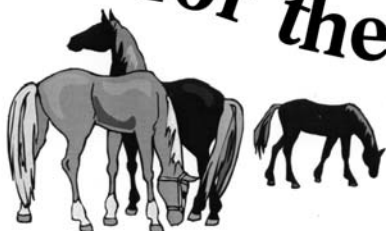

1. All fiber goats for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Sunday, July 6, 2008.
2. Open Fiber Goat Show (combined with Jr. Fiber Goat Show) will be held Tuesday, July 8, 2008 at 4:00 pm.
3. Fiber Goats will be released on Wednesday, July 9, 2008 at 11:00 pm.
4. No more than two goats per exhibitor per class will be accepted.
5. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days prior to the opening date of the fair is required. No brucellosis test is required if the animal originates from a brucellosis free state. No tuberculosis test is required if the animal is coming from an Accredited Tuberculosis-free herd. Herd test dates and certified free herd number must appear on the health certificate.
6. Vaccination against rabies is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition.

Rules and Regulations**

1. All dairy goats for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm on Thursday, July 10, 2008.
2. Open Dairy Goat Show will be held Saturday, July 12, 2008 at 9:00 am.
3. Dairy Goats will be released on Saturday, July 12, 2008 at 3:00 pm.
4. No more than two goats per exhibitor per class will be accepted.
5. Mandatory– There will be no more than 12 hours of milk in lactating animals before show time.
6. An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection issued within 30 days prior to the opening date of the fair is required. No brucellosis test is required if the animal originates from a brucellosis free state. No tuberculosis test is required if the animal is coming from an Accredited Tuberculosis-free herd. Herd test dates and certified free herd number must appear on the health certificate.
7. Vaccination against rabies is recommended. All drug and vaccine label directions must be followed, including but not limited to milk and slaughter withdrawal periods. The vaccine must be administered at least 15 days prior to entry into the exhibition.
