- All ages are welcome, a parent must register / and accompany all singers 16 and younger
- Registration (Spaces are limited and available on a first come first serve basis)
  - A Minimum Donation of \$15 Dollars is required – Donations must be turned in on Sunday at the fair grounds Karaoke or the day of event before a contestant can sing. (Checks should be made out to Mason Dixon Community Services Inc. a non-profit, tax-exempt 501 (3) (C) corporation all donations are tax-deductible) **Pledge sheets are available on line at [www.masondixonfair.com](http://www.masondixonfair.com)**

  - Idol Contestants can sign up and drop off pledges on Sunday July 11, 2010 on the Fair Grounds 5-8PM (Food Court Area) Or the day of the fair Tuesday July 13th if spaces are still available.
  - Singers will sing in order registered
- Only one song per singer - time limit is 4 minutes or less (long verse songs will be cut at 4 minutes)
- Singers can bring their own CD+G Karaoke CD (Original Disks only no copy's)
- Singers must be in the holding area 15 minutes before their round begins. Any singer not at the stage when it is their time to sing will be disqualified.
- Each performance will be judged individually.
- Appropriate dress is required, no profanity, no food, drink or smoking is allowed on stage.
- Finalists are required to be in the holding area by 9PM (contestants are required to stop by and check the leader board to find out if they have made it into one of the top 9 spots.)
- Contestants will be scored on Vocal Basics, Vocal Quality, Vocal Range, Stage Presence, Self-Expressiveness and Heartfelt Performance and Audience Response using a 100 point system.
- Final winners will be determined by a combination of contestants - 1<sup>st</sup> Round Score + Final Round Score + 25% of Total Entry Donations and Audience Dollar Voting.
- Prize - Fair Ribbons Awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Performance
- Decisions of the Judges are Final
