**Health Rules:**

**General Rules:**

1. All animals for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 4:00pm to 8:00pm on Sunday, July 9, 2017.
2. 4-H and Vocational Beef Show (combined with Open Beef Show) will be held following the Dairy Beef Show on Wednesday.
3. Beef will be released on Wednesday at 10:00pm. Bedding must be pulled back 3 feet from the perimeter.
4. Steers and heifers will be shown by breeds. There must be at least 2 animals of a breed to have a breed show. All others will be exhibited in the crossbred classes. Due to weight variances, the number of weight classes will be determined by the Superintendent. Heifers will be shown by age. No bulls allowed.
5. All steers will be weighed on the same set of scales as announced.

All exhibitors are:

- subject to the General Rules and Regulations
- expected to adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics and Guidelines for the Care of Animals
- required to comply with the General Livestock Health Requirements
