**Health Rules:**

**General Rules:**

1. All dairy goats for exhibit must be entered at the Fairgrounds from 12:00pm to 4:00pm on Thursday, July 13, 2017.
2. Open Dairy Goat Show (combined with the Junior Dairy Goat Show) will be held Friday at 6:00pm.
3. Dairy goats will be released on Saturday at 9:00pm.
4. No more than two goats per exhibitor, per class will be accepted.
5. Mandatory – there will be no more than 12 hours of milk in lactating animals before show time.

All exhibitors are:

- subject to the General Rules and Regulations
- expected to adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics and Guidelines for the Care of Animals
- required to comply with the General Livestock Health Requirements
