General Rules:

1. All youth pygmy goats must be pre-registered and arrive for check-in from 12:00pm to 4:00pm on Thursday, July 13, 2017.
2. The Junior Pygmy Goat Show will be held Friday at 7:00pm.
3. Goats will be released on Saturday at 9:00pm.
4. Entries may be restricted according to housing availability and are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
5. Premiums may be limited to two goats per exhibitor per class.
6. The show date is used as the base for age in goat classes. Showmanship ages are the exhibitors age as of January 1st.

All exhibitors are:

- subject to the General Rules and Regulations
- expected to adhere to the Code of Show Ring Ethics and Guidelines for the Care of Animals
- required to comply with the General Livestock Health Requirements

All out of state (PA) goats must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) upon arrival and check-in. For more information on health requirements refer to Health Requirements.
